To create your delicate blanket, follow these crochet instructions:

Materials Needed:

yarn Crochet hook Scissors Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

Dc: Double Crochet Tr: Treble Crochet Rep: Repeat

Sp: Space St(s): Stitch(es)

Instructions:

Row 1 (Right Side):

chain (ch) 147.

Double crochet (dc) in the 4th chain from the hook (skipping the first 3 chains; these skipped chains count as your first dc).

Dc in the next 8 stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then dc in the next 8 stitches, make a space (two chains, twice). Repeat from * to * a total of 7 times.

Dc in the next 9 stitches.

Turn your work. You should have 109 dc stitches and 18 ch-2 spaces.

Row 2:

Chain 3 (this counts as a dc throughout).

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block."

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block." Repeat from * to * 7 more times.

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space.

Turn your work.

Row 3:

Make a space (two chains, twice).

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice). Repeat from * to * 8 times.



Dc in the last 3 dc stitches.

Turn your work.

Row 4:

Make a space (two chains, twice), then "block."

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block." Repeat from * to * 7 times.

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block."

Turn your work.

Row 5:

Dc in the next 2 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice).

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice). Repeat from * to * 7 times.

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space.

Turn your work.

Row 6 (Pattern Reversed):

Make a space, "block," dc in the next 5 dc stitches.

Make a space (two chains, twice), "block," dc in the next 5 dc stitches. Repeat from * to * 7 times.

Make a space (two chains, twice), "block," dc in the next 2 dc stitches, and 1 dc in the last stitch.

Turn your work.

Row 7:

Dc in the next 2 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block."

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then "block." Repeat from * to * 7 times.

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space, and "block."

Turn your work.

Row 8:

Dc in the next 2 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), then Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice). Repeat from * to * 8 times.

Turn your work.

Row 9:

Make a space, "block," then Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, make a space (two chains, twice), "block." Repeat from * to * 8 times.

Dc in the next 3 dc stitches.

Turn your work.

Row 10:

Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice), then Dc in the next 5 dc stitches, "block," make a space (two chains, twice). Repeat from * to * 7 times.



Dc in the next 9 dc stitches. Turn your work.

Repeat Rows 1-10 for your basic pattern repeat. Afterward:


Change yarn and repeat Rows 1-10.

Change yarn and repeat Rows 1-10.

Change yarn and repeat Rows 1-10.

Fasten off and weave in all loose ends. For a polished finish, consider blocking your blanket.
